Please remember you must carry your membership card or sign in slip on you when in the Club and Gaming Room

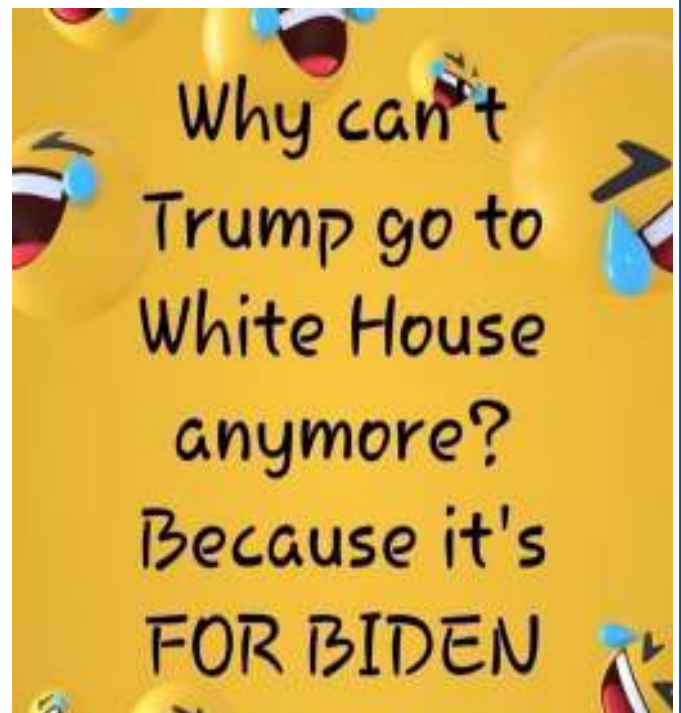
ADJUNCT NEWS
