"I can't" said the biker.

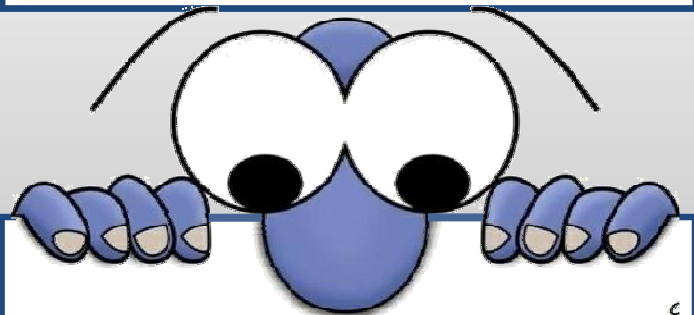
"Ok, watch me closely and I'll show you." The Officer unzipped and promptly
