## BIRTHDAY VOUCHERS STARTING AGAIN FROM 1st APRIL 2021

Just a friendly reminder about birthday vouchers, these are available for you to pick up (during office hours) in the month of your birthday e.g. If your birthday is in April then you can pick up your voucher in April, even if your birthday is not until the end of April you can still collect it at the beginning of the month, you then have the whole month of April to spend it.

When you come to collect your voucher you must have your membership card with you for our staff to check we have your correct birthday in our system. Just to clear up a couple of issues we have found with the birthday vouchers, we do not email these out to you, we do not have them enveloped waiting for you, we do not mail them out to you we also do not pay your subs for you if your birthday falls in the same month that your subs are due.
