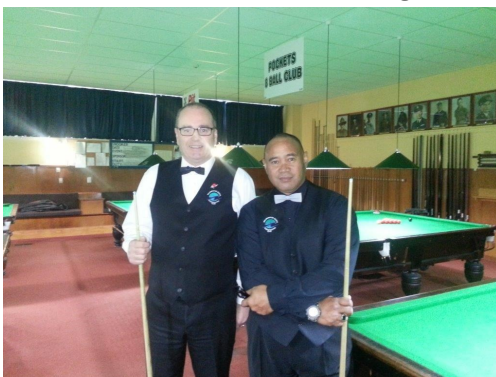
In terms of both Peter and my own performance through out the competition we both qualified to reach the last 16 in post section play, post section play is played over best of five frames.
