ADJUNCT NEWS

FISHING ADJUNCT – (aka Kaituna Fishing Club)

About 20 Cosmopolitan Club members are also part of the Fishing Adjunct membership which has a one-off joining fee of \$20 and an annual subscription of \$20.

We have a good core of members who assist in the running of Cosmopolitan Club raffles and Housie which allows us to subsidise fishing trips and our annual dinners and barbeque. We also have a weekly 'raffle' based on the Lotto bonus number.

Charter fishing is currently done out of Patea, Whanganui and Foxton but we are open to other departure points – in the past out of Tauranga, Whakatane, Porongahau, Hawkes Bay, Wellington and the Sounds. With costs and distance in mind these further afield trips are currently out of favour but we do an annual trip each November to Orui Station at Riversdale on the Wairarapa coast. Here we are accommodated in the Stations shearing quarters for 5 or 6 days and nights. A good catch of fish (eg Moki, lemon fish and) paua and crays usually is made, along with some whitebait if we are lucky. Some of this catch is kept aside for our annual barbeque in mid/late February.

A "midyear Xmas" is normally partaken in July each year in the Cosmopolitan Club which is heavily subsidised from Adjunct funds.
